Final Report now available: IIU concludes investigation into police officer conduct following fatal pedestrian/vehicle collision in Winnipeg

On December 20, 2017, the Independent Investigation Unit (IIU) issued a media release advising that it had concluded its investigation into the conduct of two members of the Winnipeg Police Service in the immediate aftermath of a traffic fatality in October in which a 23-year-old pedestrian died after he was struck by a vehicle driven by an off-duty officer. The IIU determined that no charges should be laid against either member.

The final report of the IIU was not released at that time as there were charges pending before the courts as a result of the incident. Those charges have now been dealt with and the IIU final report is now available on the IIU's website. The details of this investigation were first announced on October 20, 2017.
