IIU terminates investigation into allegation of stolen property by RCMP officer

The Independent Investigation Unit (IIU) has terminated its investigation into an allegation of stolen property by an on-duty RCMP officer.

On June 1, 2021, RCMP reported an incident to the IIU that occurred on April 2. According to the notification, on April 14 RCMP received a formal complaint from a male alleging that RCMP officers arrested him and seized personal items worth \$15,000 during a motor vehicle incident that took place north of Ile Des Chenes on April 2.

IIU investigators commenced an investigation into this matter. On June 16, the male alleging the theft contacted an IIU senior investigator to advise that he had located the jewelry initially reported to have been stolen by the RCMP.

Accordingly, the civilian director has directed that the IIU investigation be terminated and the file closed.
